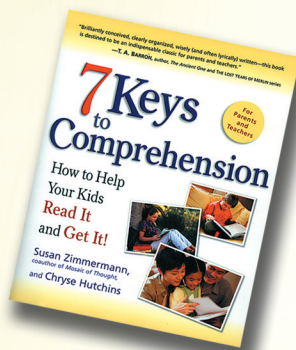

Students often miss the unstated message in fiction and are overwhelmed by content information in expository text. They need to learn how to actively expand and deepen understanding by using **INFERENCEAL THINKING**. When faced with nonfiction reading, readers benefit from knowing how to distinguish the essence of factual information by **DETERMINING IMPORTANCE IN TEXT**. This workshop will explore ways to help kids form interpretations as well as separate the nonessential from the essential by independently adopting these two comprehension strategies into their reading lives.

Learn practical strategies for:

- Designing mini-lessons for deepening reading comprehension
- Strengthening students engagement with texts
- Developing specific approaches for teaching the comprehension strategies explicitly
- Acquiring specific practices for teaching students how to “hold their thinking” and remember what they read
- Conferring with students effectively
- Making your reading/thinking process visible to students
- Developing readers who actively and independently monitor and regulate their own comprehension
- Developing book clubs as a way for students to share their thinking
- Teaching students how to infer and determine importance in text
