**D**uring this workshop, Dr. Jacobs will focus on how to unpack assessment data and integrate findings into your maps K-12 in order to improve student achievement. Participants will examine advanced uses of mapping which include integrating active literacy into every class, developing benchmark assessments, and creating both diary and consensus mapping.

Her presentation will be on her new ASCD book, *Professional Development for Curriculum Mapping: Training Modules and Maps*, co-authored with Dr. Ann Johnson. The day will be based on the four phases featured in the book for successful implementation with particular attention to phases II, III, and IV. Participants will be involved in active planning throughout the day.

- II. Launching the Process/Getting Started Creating Individual Maps, Initiating the Review Process, Master Mapping Strategies, and Developing Consensus Maps
- III. Sustaining and Integrating the Mapping Process Integrating Assessment Findings Directly into Your Map and Developing an Implementation Plan
- IV. Advanced Mapping Tasks Updating Your Maps with 21st Century Techniques

**Questions that will be addressed in this one-day workshop include:**

- How can your school integrate assessment data into maps?
- How can Mapping help your district effectively meet standards?
- How can Mapping impact student engagement to use 21st century tools?
- How can Mapping serve as a HUB for all school improvement efforts?

She works with schools and districts, K-12, on issues and practices pertaining to: curriculum reform, instructional strategies to encourage critical thinking, and strategic planning.
